I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT; Risks conditions and dangers are inherent in (meaning an integral part) of horse/equine activities, regardless of all feasible safety measures which can be taken and I agree to assume them. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to any of the following: The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, death, or loss to persons on or around the animal: The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movements, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals: Hazards including but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions: A collision, encounter and/or confrontation with another equine, another animal, a person or an object; The potential for an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, harm, or death, or loss to the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine, and/or failing to act within the ability of the participant. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to ground it will generally be from a distance of 3 ½ to 5 ½ feet and the impact may result in harm to the rider.

Timbermist Farm is not responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences or elements of nature and/or sudden movements that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. Some examples are; thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles which may walk, run, or fly near, or bite, sting a horse or person. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and according to its natural survival instincts which may include but are not limited to: stopping short, spinning around, changing directions and/or speed at will, shifting its weight, bucking, kicking, rearing, biting, or running from danger. I acknowledge that these are just some of the risks and I agree to assume others not mentioned above. I am not relying on Timbermist Farm to list all possible risks for me.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY
